Location:	Cnr Kelly Street and Towai Street
Legal description:	Lot 1 DP 21091
Size:	0.14 ha
Reserve status:	Reserve



Physical description

This is a flat, open reserve fronting both Kelly and Towai Streets.

Tangata whenua interests

This reserve is within the tribal rohe of Te Atiawa Iwi. The area is of historic and cultural significance to Pukerangiora and Puketapu.

Land status and history

In 1977 this land was transferred to the Mayor, Councillors and Citizens of the Borough of Inglewood from Moa Lands Limited, who at the time was in receivership.

Existing improvements

A small playground is located on this reserve containing a swing set. A park bench is located next to the swing set.

Uses and activities

This area is suitable for children play, picnics and is large enough for casual recreational activities.

Management objectives and specific policies

- This reserve will continue to be maintained and developed as an open space area suitable for child's play and casual recreation.
- Possible relocation of the playground from this site to the Towai Street reserve is contemplated due to ongoing drainage problems. This will be further considered during the development of the council's Playground Strategy.

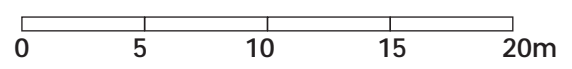
